tion by Dr S S Vithal. He narrated the history of Homoeopathy: founded by the German Dr Hahnemann about 250 yrs back but its description is available in Bhagwat Purana (5000 yrs BC), Vedas, Hippocrats, Theury, Stahle etc. He described the basic principles of Homoeopathy and its practical usage. He cleared certain misconceptions in the minds of general public. He also warned not to use patents/ mixtures available in the market since these all are non-homoeopathic. The given medicine is only homoeopathic if the prescription is based on cardinal principles of homoeopathy and cure must follow according to Herings law. All this was explained in a simple language. Due to a technical problem, multimedia slides & video cases could not be shown; still the audience listened spell bound.

Dr Randeep Nanda- teacher & head of OPD Chandigarh College, spoke on different laws and bridged the gap between modern medicine & homoeopathy. Very beautifully he clarified theory of individualization, miasms etc with help of modern sciences.

Dr Muktinder Singh- a very good orator, kept all of us spell bound by giving good examples from different scripts, clarified in a very simple language, Dr Vijaykar's theory of suppression. He scientifically explained; how a man falls ill and how cure takes place in a body.

Question / Answer session produced a good number of questions by eminent scientists/doctors/chief guest: Why are you against homoeo patents? Are mother tinctures homoeopathic or not?
