 Since 2-3 days: Chilly; Bedwetting 2-3/wk.
Puls 200 1dose SL TDS.
 5/10/01: 1-2/wk cold: since a day: acrid watery discharge. NB at night. Irritation in nose.

Allium-Ccpa 200 TDS.
 6/11/01: Enuresis SQ ie - once/wk since a mth so *Pulsatilla* 1M-1 dose.
 4/12/01: No Complaints. SL TDS.
 2/1/02: Better. No bed wetting. SL TDS. ○
