## EDITORIAL

### HOMOEOPATHIC UNIVERSITIES AND EDUCATION

It is heartening to note that several universities have taken up the homoeopathic education in right earnest. The latest to fall in line are the Osmania University at Hyderabad and the setting of a University in Uttar Pradesh. The Universities of Kanpur, Calicut and Utkal are conducting examination for the degree courses.

The Calcutta University has started B.M.S. Degree Course. It is expected that more universities will include homoeopathic education and in the near future all Degree courses in homoeopathy will be conducted by the various Indian Universities. The very intimate question which is linked up with the taking up the homoeopathic education by the Universities is the proper standard. We are aware of the genuine concern in all quarters that unless the homoeopathic education is taken up by the Universities proper standard in homoeopathic education cannot possibly be achieved and in fact this has been the main reason why there was a demand for the Universities to take up homoeopathic education.

Future of homoeopathy in this country will depend upon the students who are coming out from the various colleges and unless these students are properly trained they will not be able to practise homoeopathy successfully. Therefore, it is the prime duty of the Central Council of Homoeopathy and various Universities to ensure that the affiliated colleges have adequate facilities for teaching and they do not lack any equipment besides having well-equipped hospitals where clinical training to the students could be imparted and they get all the necessary experience in the management of cases which one gets in every day practice. Thus the various faculties of homoeopathy will have to strive hard to maintain a good standard of homoeopathic education to avoid the unfortunate catastrophe. It is expected of the homoeopathic profession through the National Organisation of Homoeopaths, viz., H.M.A.I and the Central Council of Homoeopathy to remain alive to the situation and to remain watchful so that proper standard can be maintained.
