

VALUABLE HOMOEOPATHIC THERAPEUTICS IN GYNAECOLOGY AND OBSTETRICS **

Dear Dr. Mollie Hunton and Colleagues:

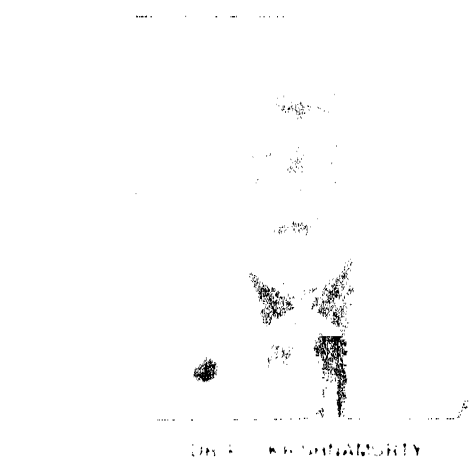
Toxemia of the pregnancy is a fascinating subject in homoeopathic therapeutics. The condition runs into the progeny. This author evaluated the symptoms of 1000 patients and repertorised the rubrics. The important aspect of the clinical investigation was that the drug Mercurius Solubilis came as a drug of choice in the majority of the cases as a block or miasmatic remedy. The drug was used both as a preventive in the patients who had toxemia in the previous pregnancy or their mothers who had toxemia during pregnancy. In eighty per cent of the cases the full term of the pregnancies were uneventful and the deliveries were normal! Ten per cent of the cases were drop-outs and the remaining ten per cent had still-born births.

There is another important observation in these cases. Merc. Sol can be used for any other chronic illness as a miasmatic block if the patient has a history of toxemia or its incidence in his or her mother.

Four cases of enuresis who did not get well by seemingly indicated homoeopathic remedies, got well by one single dose of Merc. Sol IM. In six cases of retinitis pigmentosa (RP); the tubular vision was very much improved. In this author's forty years of experience many more cases were helped with this block remedy!

An interesting case of toxoplasmosis is worth mentioning. Mrs. AN aged 33 years had 4 deliveries of monstrous-child births, two still-born births and two infants died a few hours after delivery. She consulted me on 15-6-1988. As you know well, Toxoplasma Gondii is implicated as a culprit. But in this case herpes virus was observed in the serological investigations.

The patient had a profound feeling of constriction of vagina which led to the prescription of Cactus. This



rubric is listed in the Kent's Repertory, both for vagina and ovary, Page 716. Merc. Sol and Psorinum were selected which were listed in a couple of rubrics of the repertorial analysis of the patient. Believe it or not! The patient had normal full term delivery and both the mother and her daughter are hale and hearty!

A lady aged 25 years consulted me for galactorrhoea since six months after delivery. After nursing the child the mother had to remove the milk with breast-pump! Tons of hormones and twice operations, did not solve the problem! She was given Tubercullinum. Bov. CM one dose on the prominent indications of, love of travel, desires cold milk and she was unusually tall to her age! The mother had normal secretion of milk for the rest of the one and half years.

Falling of hair from head during pregnancy after parturition, menopause; are common problems for women, and trouble for the doctor. All the above rubrics are listed on page 120 in the Kent's Repertory.

A lady Mrs. P.N. aged 25 years consulted me for unusual hair fall from *genetalia*. The rubric, hair falling out is listed in the Kent's Repertory on page 718. Seven remedies are listed there. From among those remedies *Helleborus* was selected, because the patient had the history of hydrocephalus in her childhood as an important and leading punctuation in her past history of the significant illnesses. Five years old troublesome and embarrassing symptom disappeared with one dose of *Hell. IM!*

This author compiled single remedy rubrics of the Kent's Repertory and a few other repertories. They are very useful not because there is no other choice for the selection of the remedy for that particular or general symptom, which is prominent, but because that single remedy either appeared in the original provings or in addition it was verified in the hands of astute homoeopaths if the remedy is second grade or first grade! Tyler very much emphasised it in her writings, the importance of the single remedy rubrics!

My learned teacher Pierre Schmid requested me to compile such important rubrics. I am also the privileged student of Dr. EW Hubbard, Blakie, John Weir and William Griggs. Sometimes, *Boeninghausen's*, symptom division of sensation, location, modality and concomitant, becomes characteristic symptom in the patient. If that rubric is listed with a single remedy of any grade the drug becomes important for the choice of prescription.

Abortion tendency to : (715) *Plumbum* is the only remedy in the first grade. A lady who aborted twelve times, with the characteristic symptom of hypersthaesia of the skin, was given *Plumbum IM* one dose. She never allowed to touch her abdomen or any part of her body, because the touch hurts her, she delivered full term healthy infant!

Tyler in her Drug Pictures (Page, 663) greatly emphasises this valuable tip, mentioned by Nash and verified by her.

The following single remedy rubrics from Kent's Repertory greatly helped this author for many patients!

Drugs underlined are first grade, with apostrophe are second grade and mentioned as it is, are in third grade.

This author treated many cases of Nymphomania.

The following rubrics from Kent's Repertory greatly helped this author.

Mind, Nymphomania and the sub-rubrics (page 68) *Genetalia*, Female, Desire, increased and other subrubrics; (716) :

Cimicifuga Racemosa or *Actea Racemosa* is a good remedy in Gynaecology and Obstetrics.

The Wonderful concomitancy of uterine complaints and joint troubles, especially small joints, is very useful!

Castorium, is an out of the way remedy, beautifully helped this author in the illnesses of women when the symptoms are indicated! Hysterical symptoms, especially day blindness, (cannot endure light). Nervous women, who do not recover fully, continually irritable, with debilitating sweats, constant Yawning, starts and frightful dreams. *Dysmenorrhoea*, like conditions which are not cured by other remedies!

Symphoricarpus is another out of the way and valuable remedy which acts like a specific in severe cases of morning sickness! *Amygdalus Persica* (Peach Tree), *Aletris Farinosa* and *Apomorphia* are also helpful. In the vomiting of the Alcoholics, *Apomorphia*, is a specific.

There are two important books in homoeopathy for the Gynaecologist and Obstetrician. *Accoucher's Emergency Manual*, by Yingling: A big text book on Gynaecology and obstetrics by, Dewey.
