Mr R (Case 4001). 49 yrs old, A lean, thin farmer, living in district Satna, MP was brought to the clinic by his son with the following COMPLAINTS
Thyroid cyst in the left side for a long time.
There was no pain in the cyst but gets pain in the left trapezius muscle. The pain is relieved by moving the head and rubbing with hand.

PHYSICAL GENERALS

DESIRE: Nothing specific.

SLEEP: Good, 10-4 am. No dreams.

APPETITE: POOR. THIRST: less.

PERSPIRATION: Normal.

STOOL: Satisfactory.

VOICE: Voice gets cracked in high pitch.

Hands and feet get cramps at time.

THERMAL: Chilly patient.

PAST HISTORY: Eczema on one foot at the age of 14-15 yrs. He used to have recurrent coryza in his childhood and recurrent mouth ulcer.

FAMILY HISTORY: Father died of old age at 84 yrs. Mother died at 45 yrs due to PUO.

TEMPERAMENT: Calm and quiet rather suppressive

nature. Farmer by occupation, also is the head (Sarpanch) of his village. He has to maintain secrecy of the person whom he deals with. Memory not good for things he keeps.

INVESTIGATION AND TREATMENT

Thyroid test 06. 01. 07

T3: 162. 0. (60. - 181. 0)

T4: 9. 0 (4. 5-126)

TSH: 0.09 Low. (0.35-5.50)

10.03.07: *Thuja* 200/1 and *Chel* Q 10 drops bd. (Phatak goitre left side indicates only one medicine- *Chel*)

07.04.07: Size of the thyroid cyst is reducing SL for one month. Continued *Chel* Q bd.

11.05.07: The cyst vanished. The son of the patient is still in contact with me and as per his latest report the patient is keeping fit and fine.

Reasons: Phataks Rep

Goitre: *Only Chel*

Goitre --> Growth --> Sycotic Miasm --> *Thuj*
So single dose of *Thuja* followed by *Chel* Q BD
