In the first volume beginning with the Elements of Homoeopathic Pharmacy, the following topics have been presented in a very simple and brief manner in the light of his rich practical experience: The Study of Materia Medica, Random Notes on Some Remedies, Some Notes on the Nosodes, Use of the Bowel Nosodes,

Some New Proving, Some Hints on Case Taking, Analysis and Evaluation of the Symptoms, The Value of the Repertory, Repertorisation, Introduction to Boger's Synoptic Key, The Pocket Repertory, Prophylactics in homoeopathy, Some Cross References to Kent's Repertory. While going through 'The Random Notes on Some Remedies', the reading of each remedy has opened the vistas of new experience. Dr Sankaran has pointed out the relevance of Alumina in the chapter, Alumina in the prevalent background of the excessive use of aluminium. He has pondered over the possibility of turning Ammonium Carb into the common medicine giving similar importance as given to Carbo Veg. The importance of Arnica is very significant in the

present life style of our modern civilization restricting the workload to the concerned limb of the body alone. He has interestingly presented the possibility of the effect of Arnica in the different cases such as the over exertion of the fingers of the typist, the vocal cord of the singer, the limbs of the athlete, and the eyes of the proof reader. In the second volume, the following topics have been presented in the respective chapters to be useful to one and all, from young student to the well experienced: Potency Problem, Repetition of doses, Clinical Relationship, Dietetic Restriction, When the indicated remedy fails, The importance of aetiology, Pathology in homoeopathy, Homoeopathy and Surgery, Limitations of homoeopathy, Some recent research and advances and Collected Writings.
