

How a Rx Modifies the Person?

This case is a perfect example of it. Also it is worth reporting to show the unusual action of Puls in warts/corns.

Mr RR, 38yrs, residing at Cuffe Parade had initially come to me in 1994 when he stayed at Worli. After taking medicines for a year he disappeared...well this act was the result of good homoeopathic cure! He surfaced again last week after 14 yrs in Feb 2008. And what a coincidence while I was referring the old follow-up, I came across a fabulous result wherein the patient had an acute episode of UTI which was cured till date no recurrence of the same symptoms, this makes the reporting mandatory for this issue.

In the past, he had an acute episode of urinary complaints in 1996- very severe symptoms - Left sided pain, tremendous pain. Would roll due to pain; could not pass urine for 6 hrs at a stretch. Crystals were found in the urine. Thirstlessness. Chilly patient.

ASSOCIATED MENTALS WERE: Weeps with pain and feels better. Irritable. Confidence decreased. Indecisive. Changeable mood. And at that time, never wanted to marry.

Puls 200 given QDS. Pain had settled immediately. Over a period of 6-9 mths, *Puls* was decided as his constitutional itself with *Thuja* as the Intercurrent. Last potency given was *Puls* 1M. After that the patient was much relieved. No further episodes. Other symptoms also better.

In 2008, he has come for warts., which began in 2007: Warts on face, neck, thumb, white, rough,

cauliflower-like. Cauterized twice, but continued to get them recurrently.

His old complaints of asthma still persists. Takes inhalers BD, dyspnoea on exertion.

His resistance is poor. A/F Getting wet, sun stroke and change of weather.

Since 2008 has high Cholesterol. He has started walking 45 minutes regularly since a mth as has also gained 4 kgs since a year.

On 28-1-08: I prescribed *Thuja* 200 since Sycotic miasm is predominant now with the wart, obesity, high cholesterol etc.

On 5-1-08: Slight change in wart. By now, the old SCR was found and the above described history seen. Now a dose of *Puls* 200. Because it has helped as much and more than the acute, also covered the constitutional traits in him. He has even got married recently. You recollect that he had been opposed to the idea of marriage earlier.

On 12-1-08: Wart on finger >³ now it is smooth, painless and nail has grown above it ie longer than it. Earlier this finger wart was very painful on any touch and was very rough like a cauliflower being higher than the thumbnail, and he had to cover it with a bandaid, to protect it. Now on 12th, he came without the bandaid!

This result of the acute pain was enough to warrant our including this unusual case of wart almost like a hard corn in this Acutes issue.

Q1: Sir in the Kent's Repertory, there is a rubric "Conscious of Womb." In which conditions does one have that sort of sensation?

A1: Well Dr Dharti, many females suffer from Pelvic Inflammatory Disease. In this condition the uterus is bulky with profuse bleeding from the vagina. It is also frequently accompanied by a constant sensation of heaviness of the lower abdomen with or without sore pain. This is the time when the patient says that she has a swelling of the uterus, and always feels aware of the womb and we refer it to "Conscious of Womb."

Q2: Sir, 2 months old male child has been diagnosed to have "Epidermatolysis Bullosa" since 25 days. The parents say that it started after DPT vaccination. The Pediatrician does not agree. Kindly reply if we can help this patient in any way?

A2: Epidermatolysis Bullosa is a rare congenital skin disorder of an autosomal dominant inheritance and characterized by serous bullae that heal without scarring. The severe variety of the above ie Epidermatolysis Bullosa Dystrophica is characterized by atrophy of blistered areas, severe scarring, extensive denudation and separation or cleavage of the basal cell plasma membranes from the basement membrane and nail changes. It is most often present at birth or in early infancy and occurs in both autosomal dominant and recessive forms. Since it's a congenital disorder, we cannot

cure it but depending upon the symptoms, palliation can be done.

Q3: Can we allow the use of Antipyretics (allopathic) in cases of fever?

A3: Fever, basically is the one of the defense mechanisms of the body. It is a vital method to maintain the internal milieu or the internal environment of the body. Hence artificial reduction of fever needs some thought. Yes patients do come frequently to us with the hope of getting their fever reduced immediately. But whether or not one should do it depends upon the justification of the event. A physician of any school should view fever as mentioned above, as a means of overcoming the attack on the body by external agents. Fever means fight, which is an indication of fighter immunity of the body. At the same time one should be aware if it is accompanied with other complications like convulsions due to a high rise, hypoxic brain damage due to sun-stroke etc. If there is a high possibility of complications due to fever per se, only then one may seriously attempt to reduce it by artificial means. The age old practice of tepid water sponging in fever is quite safe and equally effective even today. I think that this should be first adopted. In the homoeopathic parlance we have very effective acute remedies to reduce artificially fever, which if required can be given in high potencies. Hence the need for analgesic is not necessary for conscientious homoeopaths.
