PAST HISTORY AND FAMILY HISTORY: Fa: DM, Haemorrhoids

PHYSICAL EXAMINATION

Temp: 98.6° F. BP: 130/90 mm of Hg. P: 72/min. Wt: 57 kgs.

Nose: Congested, hypertrophied turbinates.

Tongue: Coated thin white.

RS: Clear. CVS: Normal. P/A: Liver and Spleen soft, non tender. CNS: Normal. P/R: No sentinel tag, fissure seen, Proctoscopy finding: Distended rectal veins.

CLINICAL DIAGNOSIS: Perennial Allergic Rhinitis, 2nd degree hemorrhoids, Obesity.

MATERIA MEDICA DIFFERENTIATION

Remedies that come up are *Puls*, *Kali-carb* and *Calc-carb*

But the tremendous anxiety, irritability and strong attachment to family, along with desire for company tilts the balance towards *Kali-carb*

INTERCURRENT TOTALITY

Weakness after disease as concomitant of chief complaint

Bleeding piles, which were aggravated during pregnancy and overall anxious and irritable nature. All these point towards Tubercular miasm

INTERCURRENT REMEDY- *Tub-bov*

Follow up Summary

Patient was given *Kali-carb* 200 1P on 19/12/08. Repetition was kept weekly till patient improved - Coryza, sneezing and nasal discharges. Bleeding per rectum started on 9/1/09 for which repetition was increased from 1P to 3P. She remembers interspaced with *Tub-b* 1M single dose. After this gradual bleeding stopped and patient was maintained on 3P for a further 4 weeks. As per the last follow up on 24/4/09 pt is asymptomatic. Also the ancillary measures helped a lot in decreasing the intensity and frequency of complaints. This summer of 2009 has been the best.
