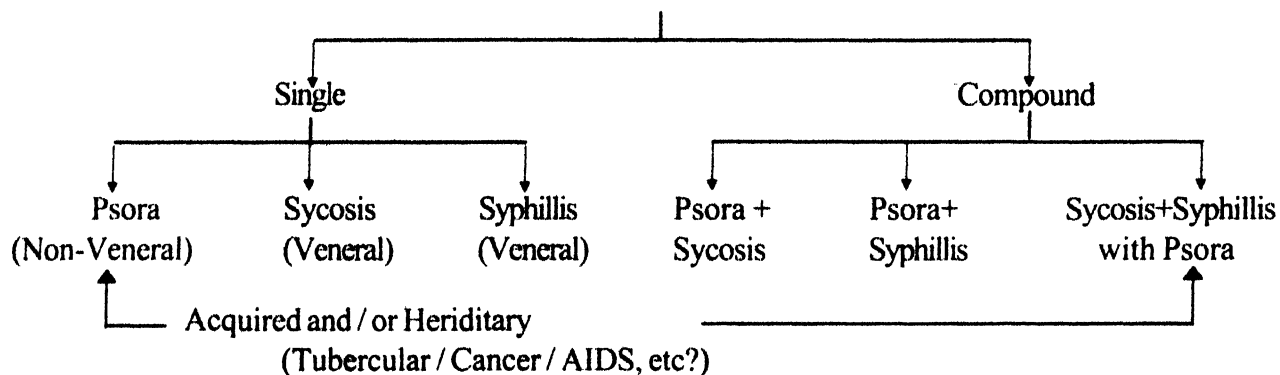


# Is Tubercular the 4<sup>th</sup> Miasm?

We all know aph 78 of 6<sup>th</sup> Ed of Organon: "The true natural Chronic disease are those that arise from a Chronic miasm, which when left to themselves, unchecked by employment of remedies, always get worse, notwithstanding the best mental and corporeal regimen,

and torment patient to with ever increasing sufferings". "But when practitioners, carefully examine the patient for clue to remedy or miasmatic remedy, we find it difficult to find a separate and clear picture of any of the 3 fundamental miasm.

## Miasmatic-True Nature-Aphorism 78



Dr Hahnemann and his true followers like Dr J H Allen, Dr J T Kent, Dr H A Roberts and others, also discussed the concept of the 3 Fundamental chronic Miasms, but never categorized a separate nomenclature to Tubercular Miasm or Cancer or AIDS

- 1) Fibrotic / Formative type
- 2) Generative / Destructive type
- 3) Fibro-Degenerative type

We, the new generation of Homoeopaths, are nullifying the original concept of Miasms. I think the time has come to clarify the concept of Tubercular Diathesis, and whether necessary to separate it to a distinct miasm or not?

It is true that some chronic disease like Tuberculosis / Cancer / Sarcoma, AIDS and other have had established from clinico-pathological point by three distinct character.

Our Indian Stalwarts like Late Dr J N Kanjilal, Dr S P Dey, Dr R P Patel and others have never accepted the concept of Tubercular Miasm as a separate or distinct miasm. It is to be clear when we read the statement of Dr J H Allen under the chapter of "Psora and Pseudo-Psora" Page 23 of The Chronic Miasms thus: "When a suppression took place in an organism where two or more Miasms were present, all the conditions above mentioned were magnified and intensified, as is frequently seen when Psora and Syphillis are perfectly combined by hereditary transmission. I say 'Perfectly Combined' for there can be no other such perfection of bond of the Miasms with the life forces, as is produced through heredity.

The Tubercular Diathesis is the result of such a union, which is one of the profounded in its depth of action of



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any diseased state or condition that can be named. So, we see the Pseudo-psora is worse than Psora by itself and the same thing may be said when Psora and Syco-sis are combined, but they do not compare in their destructive action as when the Tubercular element is present.

Moreover we know that the miasmatic state may be mixed together, as we also know in connection with two dissimilar diseases meeting together, at the same time in the living human organism. So we obviously get in our daily practice the combined state of Psora and Syco-sis or Psora and Syphillis or Syco-sis and Syphillis with Psora. But we can never use the term Pseudo-psora as Tubercular Miasm where Dr Hahnemann himself explain the mixed miasmatic state very nicely.

Hope, the Editor and other authors of NJH highlight the concrete concept of Tubercular Miasm for the benefit of new generation of Homoeopathic Physicians.
